

# Pray Together With

Join us in prayer for these needs from partners in the Great Commission.

## For Field Workers

Praise God for the many people who heard the gospel for the first time at Easter outreaches around the world. Pray for wisdom for Christar workers in following up with those interested in learning more.

Pray for continued courage and safety for believers in a Muslim community who have faced interrogation and persecution.

Ask God to provide a national pastor for a church in Japan.

Praise the Lord for bringing people from at least eight countries to an English class outreach in the United States. Pray they will understand what they hear at the Bible time after class and desire to read God's Word in their own languages.

Lift up Southeast Asian believers in five communities participating in church-planting training led by a Christar team. Ask God to work through them to expand His Body in places where few have heard the gospel.

## For Partner Churches

Lift up a North Carolina church of 2,000 being led by its pastor to "tithe" from its membership for missions. Ask that this congregation will faithfully move toward its goal of sending 200 cross-cultural workers.

Ask God to provide the funds a Texas church needs to renovate a recently purchased building. In addition to holding church activities in this space, they would like to use it to host new ethnic churches forming in the area.

Praise God for providing a new senior pastor for a congregation in South Carolina. Pray for him as he juggles increased responsibilities, and ask the Lord to provide a worship leader for this church.

Lift up a church in Alabama that recently sent a family to serve in one of the world's most dangerous countries. Pray church members will wisely support and communicate with them in ways that will not endanger the family's presence in their host community.

Pray that a Pennsylvania church would find opportunities to reach out locally and abroad as its leaders develop a plan to engage more of the congregation in cross-cultural outreach.



## For Missions-Minded Believers

Praise God for believers in the United States who are giving their time to serve as English practice partners with Muslim immigrants in their communities. Pray that through these relationships, many would be drawn to Jesus.

Pray for a giver's mom who does not know Jesus and has been diagnosed with a fast-paced illness. Ask the Lord to surround her with believers, including Christian doctors and nurses, who will be a strong witness to her during these days.

Lift up a giver undergoing a series of tests to determine the cause of chronic illness. Pray for clarity and that doctors will work as a team toward holistic treatment plans.

Praise God for giving workers in North Africa new teammates! Pray for grace as these new workers adjust and begin language study.

Pray with two givers that their lives will continually reflect the light of Christ among the caregivers and medical teams with whom they interact on a regular basis.

## For the CMCUS\*

Pray that CMCUS Church Partnership Reps will have mutually encouraging visits with pastors and church missions leaders.

Ask for wisdom for pre-field coaches as they come alongside those preparing to leave for the field. Ask that their efforts will help new workers arrive on the field well-equipped for cross-cultural life and ministry.

Praise the Lord that over a dozen workers participated in a recent RENEW debriefing retreat. Pray that this time of refreshment will continue to energize and encourage them for continued ministry. Especially lift up those seeking God's guidance for next steps.

Pray for insight and skill in creating resources to help believers from all parts of the Body of Christ participate in the Great Commission.

Praise God for using Christar's partnership with Switchboard to mobilize believers to use their professional skills to help cross-cultural teams through remote volunteering. Pray that more "Kingdom Consultants" will serve in this way.
